# Policy 83.00 Driver's License, ID Card, Employer Identification Number on Motor Vehicle Transactions

**Section:** 4. Motor Vehicle Registration Requirements



## **Authority:**

R.S. 32:707 Administrative

#### **Definitions:**

- **Driver's License** A license issued by this state or another state that is evidence of the applicant's ability to operate a motor vehicle.
- Employer Identification Number (EIN) Similar to a Social Security number, the EIN is used to identify companies.
- **Identification Card** A credential issued by this state or another state that serves as an identity document for an individual, but is not evidence of an individual's ability to operate a motor vehicle.



### Requirements:

- Applicable paperwork needed to transfer the title of the vehicle
- A driver's license, identification card, or EIN must be provided at time of application for registration.
  - Employer Identification Number The EIN must be included on the Vehicle Application (<u>DPSMV1799</u>) form whenever a vehicle is being registered in a company's name.
  - Driver's License / Identification Card Number The driver's license or identification card number must be included on the Vehicle Application (<u>DPSMV1799</u>) form, when a vehicle is titled/registered to an individual or multiple individuals.
- A license plate will not be issued for vehicle registered in the name of an individual until a
  driver's license or identification card issued by this state or another state is provided.
