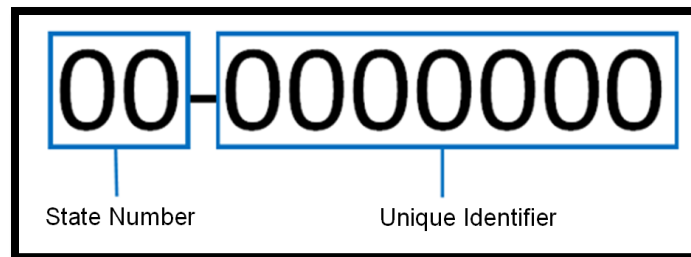

Definitions:

- **Driver's License** – A license issued by this state or another state that is evidence of the applicant's ability to operate a motor vehicle.
- **Identification Card** – A credential issued by this state or another state that serves as an identity document for an individual, but is not evidence of an individual's ability to operate a motor vehicle.
- **Employer Identification Number (EIN)** – Similar to a Social Security number, the EIN is used to identify companies.



Requirements:

- [Applicable paperwork](#) needed to transfer the title of the vehicle
- A driver's license, identification card, or EIN must be provided at time of application for registration.
 - **Employer Identification Number** - The EIN must be included on the *Vehicle Application (DPSMV1799)* form whenever a vehicle is being registered in a company's name.
 - **Driver's License / Identification Card Number** - The driver's license or identification card number must be included on the *Vehicle Application (DPSMV1799)* form, when a vehicle is titled/registered to an individual or multiple individuals.
- A license plate will not be issued for vehicle registered in the name of an individual until a driver's license or identification card issued by this state or another state is provided.
