**General:**

- If a license plate / validation sticker is lost or stolen, the registered owner should make immediate application for a replacement.

**Requirements:**

- A completed vehicle application form (DPSPMV 1799). The applicant must complete "Section C" on the reverse side of the form.
- If the vehicle is registered to a company, the person signing for the company must list his position as well.

**Fees:**

- **Plate Fee:**
  - \$10.00 - replacement fee
  - \$8.00 - handling fee
  - Any additional fees due based on plate type and vehicle value
- **Validation Sticker Fee:**
  - \$10.00 - replacement fee
  - \$8.00 - handling fee
  - Any additional fees to validate the sticker to current date

**Notes:**

- Public agencies are required to pay for replacement plates, although the initial plate is free.
- If the owner has reason to believe that the plate/validation sticker was stolen, he should furnish an affidavit or information of fact to the department. The owner may also report the offense to his local law enforcement agency.
