Definitions (These definitions apply only to a transfer made pursuant to the Louisiana Uniform Transfer to Minors Act):

- Adult An individual who has attained the age of 22 years¹
- Minor An individual who has not attained the age of 22 years¹

General:

- This policy only applies to transfers of property designated as custodial property.
 - A transfer (not designated as custodial property) to a person eighteen (18) years of age or older should follow Section 4, Policy 2.00, <u>Basic Requirements for</u> Obtaining a Certificate of Title.
- A vehicle may be titled in the name of a minor younger than 22 years of age and a designated custodian.
 - A title may be transferred from the custodian solely to the minor, without transfer documentation, once the minor reaches 22 years of age, marries, and/or is emancipated.
 - The vehicle may be **sold** or **donated** to the minor by the custodian once the minor has reached eighteen (18) years of age.
- If the custodian dies before the minor becomes eligible, once a new custodian is appointed, a corrected title can be processed to indicate the new custodian.

Required Documentation:

- Applicable transfer documentation is required to transfer the vehicle title/registration.
- Documentation is **not** required to prove custodianship
- All transfer documentation must be completed using the following format:
