Definitions:

A motor vehicle that sustains cosmetic damages caused by hail, equivalent to seventyfive percent or more of its market value as a result of costs for repairs to items such as
windshields, windows, and rear glass; exterior paint and paint materials; and body
damage such as dents shall not be deemed a total loss and salvaged; however, such
vehicles shall be issued a branded title indicating the vehicle has sustained hail damage.

Requirements:

 A disclosure of hail damage statement (<u>DPSMV1637</u>) signed by both the transferor and transferee must be submitted as a part of the supporting documents surrendered for issuance of a title with a "Hail-Damaged" brand upon the face of the title.
