Definitions:

- A "Felony for Classes D or E" in this case is a conviction for a felony act in which a motor vehicle was used.

Requirements:

- A mandatory suspension is required for 730 days if the violation is after 8/15/07 and 365 days if the violation is prior to 8/15/07.
(See Section II, Policy/Procedure #3.0 for Felony driving prohibitions for Classes "A", "B" or "C" licenses.)

Method of Compliance:

- Violator must serve the suspension period.
- The \$60.00 reinstatement fee must be paid in addition to any other fees owed for statutory requirements.
