General:

- Receipt of a conviction of Manslaughter, Negligent Homicide, or Vehicular Homicide resulting from the operation of a motor vehicle requires a two-year suspension of the individual's driving privileges.

Compliance:

- The violator must serve the mandatory two (2) year suspension period.

Fees:

- \$60.00 reinstatement fee in addition to fee owed for other statutory requirements.
