Description of Incident: Southern University at New Orleans Police is investigating a report of a burglary in SUNO's housing. On Wednesday, June 13, 2018 at approximately 10:50pm, a resident of SUNO Housing reported that he secured his bedroom door/front door and while he was away from his apartment, someone broke into his room and stole items. The Police are currently gathering evidence and information in an effort to identify person involved in this incident.
