| <b>Description of Incident:</b> <p>Southern University at New Orleans Police is investigating a report of a missing person. On Monday, August 6, 2018 at approximately 4:22pm, a resident reported that his mother, Ms. Dale E. Brown, was missing. The resident stated that on Friday July 27 at approximately 9:00AM, his mother was visiting him and she went outside to smoke a cigarette after a disagreement with his sister. The resident stated that was the last time he saw or heard from his mother.</p> <p>Ms. Brown has been seen twice in the uptown area of New Orleans since her disappearance.</p> <p>Ms. Brown is described as a black female, 5 feet 4 inches tall, slender build, and weighs about 140lbs. Ms. Brown also has gray and black colored shoulder length hair, but usually wear wigs. She was last seen wearing a purple, pink and white colored flower shirt, with khaki pants, black slippers and a stocking cap covering her hair. Ms. Brown have several medical conditions and maybe in early stages of dementia.</p> <p>The Police are currently gathering evidence and information in an effort to locate Ms. Brown. If anyone has information regarding this incident, please contact Investigator Claudell Logan at 504-286-5290.</p> <p>This information is being released in accordance with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act.
