Description of Incident:

Southern University at New Orleans Police and The New Orleans Police are investigating a report of several vehicle burglaries in the 3rd and 7th Districts including 2 on SUNO's Park Camps and 2 in the Pontchartrain Park neighborhood. On Sunday, December 9, 2018 at approximately 3:30am, it was reported that there were a rash of auto burglaries and they were primarily targeting marked and unmarked police cars.

During that investigation, the Southern University at New Orleans and New Orleans Police Departments arrested all subjects who were found to be in possession of stolen property from the auto burglaries.

The Police are currently gathering evidence and information in an effort to identify other persons involved in this incident.
