Description of Incident: The Southern University at New Orleans Police Department is investigating a reported burglary in Student Housing. The burglary was reported by a resident on Friday, December 13, 2019 at 9:10pm and may have occurred between December 11-13, 2019. The resident reported the front door was left unlocked, but her suite door was locked and secured prior to leaving. The resident stated she returned to find that her suite door had been force opened, room ransacked, and items missing. If you have any information about the identity of the perpetrators, please contact the Southern University at New Orleans Police Department at (504) 286-5290. Information can also be related anonymously to Crime Stoppers of Greater New Orleans at 504-822-1111. Information that leads to an arrest could earn up to \$2,500 in cash. Anyone calling with information should refer to SUNO PD Item # L-18-19 or NOPD Item # L-19028-19. This information is being released in accordance with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1990. The Clery Act requires all colleges and universities that participate in federal financial aid programs to keep and disclose information about crime on and near their respective campuses, including timely warnings of crimes that may represent a serious or ongoing threat to the safety of students or employees. All residents should make certain their doors and windows are secured. Remember that safety is everyone's responsibility and all suspicious activity should be reported to Campus Police at 504-286-5290 or 504-884-1769.
