Description of Suspect:

Six (6) Unknown Black Males and three (3) of which were armed; one (1) wearing a gray polo shirt, black pants, and black shoes.

Description of Incident:

The Southern University at New Orleans Police Department is investigating an alleged robbery that occurred on Tuesday, August 13, 2019 at approximately 11:06pm. It was reported that a SUNO housing resident and his visitor, also a SUNO Housing resident were robbed inside his apartment by six (6) Unknown Black Males, three (3) of which were armed.

If you have any information about the identity of the perpetrators, please contact the Southern University at New Orleans Police Department at (504) 286-5290. Information can also be related anonymously to Crime Stoppers of Greater New Orleans at 504-822-1111. Information that leads to an arrest could earn up to \$2,500 in cash. Anyone calling with information should refer to SUNO PD Item # H-11-19 or NOPD Item # H-18138-19.

This information is being released in accordance with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1990. The Clery Act requires all colleges and universities that participate in federal financial aid programs to keep and disclose information about crime on and near their respective campuses, including timely warnings of crimes that may represent a serious or ongoing threat to the safety of students or employees.
