AGGRAVATED BATTERY BY SHOOTING

The New Orleans Police Department and Southern University at New Orleans Police Departments are investigating a report of Aggravated Battery by Shooting on Wednesday, November 23, 2022.

At approximately 10:55 a.m., a shooting occurred in the Natural Sciences parking lot located at the corner of Press Drive and Emmett Bashful Blvd. One person was injured and drove to University Medical Center. None of the suspects are believed to be related to Southern University at New Orleans. This incident was isolated and did not impact any other areas of the campus.

This information is being released in accordance with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act. The Clery Act requires all colleges and universities that participate in federal financial aid programs to keep and disclose information about crime on and near their respective campuses, including timely warnings of crimes that may represent a serious or ongoing threat to the safety of students or employees.

SAFETY TIP: The Southern University at New Orleans Police Department reminds all community members of the following information about violence and inappropriate actions.

- Trust your instincts. If you feel uneasy or sense something is wrong, do what you can to get out of that situation or call for assistance.
- Be active in supporting a safe and respectful community. If you see others engaging in disrespectful or inappropriate actions, speak up, get involved, or contact the police to assist.
- If you have imminent concerns for the safety of others, call the police to ask for assistance.

All residents, students, faculty, and staff should remember that safety is everyone's responsibility, and all suspicious activity should be reported to SUNO Police Department at 504-286-3355.
