

ARMED ROBBERY

The Southern University at New Orleans Police Department (SUNOPD) and New Orleans Police Department (NOPD) are investigating an armed robbery that occurred at SUNO Residential Housing. On February 14, 2024, at approximately 1:15 pm a student was robbed at gunpoint in their apartment by their guest. There is no active threat to the university. This was an isolated incident and the suspects are known to the victim.

This information is being released in accordance with the federal Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1990. The Clery Act requires all colleges and universities that participate in federal financial aid programs to keep and disclose information about crime on and near their respective campuses, including timely warnings of crimes that may represent a serious or ongoing threat to the safety of students or employees.
